Families are encouraged to apply early as some classes fill quickly.

## THE APPLICATION CHECKLIST

The following Application Checklist is provided to guide you through the application process

### 1. FORMS TO BE COMPLETED IN [QMS.OPENAPPLY.COM](https://qms.openapply.com)

- QMS Admission Application Form** - Completed in full by the Parent/Guardian. This form must include agency details (if applicable) and credit card information for the \$200 application fee.
- QMS Student Questionnaire** - Completed by the student in their own words.
- QMS Teacher Reference Form** - Completed by a current teacher who knows the student well. You will be prompted to enter a teacher's name and email during the application process. The reference form will be sent directly to the teacher.
- QMS Equestrian Application Form (OPTIONAL)** - Completed by Parent/Guardian or student if the student wishes to participate in the equestrian program.

### 2. FORMS TO BE UPLOADED TO [QMS.OPENAPPLY.COM](https://qms.openapply.com)

- Report Cards (School Transcripts)** - A COPY of the most recent report from the current school year AND the school year-end report from the previous year.
- Birth Certificate** - A COPY of the student's birth certificate.
- Photograph** - A clear, colour, close-up digital photograph of the student
- Citizenship Document – For STUDENTS born outside of Canada** – A COPY of the student's passport must be provided. A copy of the student's Canadian Permanent Resident/Landed Immigrant documentation must also be provided to qualify for Canadian fees.
- Citizenship Document – For PARENTS born outside of Canada** – If requesting Canadian Boarding Fees, a COPY of the parent's Canadian Permanent Resident/Landed Immigrant documentation OR a copy of their valid Work or Study Visa must be provided to qualify for Canadian fees.

## 4. THE ADMISSIONS INTERVIEW

Once the Admissions team has reviewed the completed application, the student's parent or agent will be contacted to schedule an interview with the student. This will take place in person, by phone, on-line or using another method that is convenient for the family. For international students, assessment of English proficiency may be required.

## 5. THE ADMISSIONS DECISION

Our Admissions department will notify all applicants of their decision when assessment has been successfully completed. All applications are subject to available space.

## 6. REGISTRATION

If accepted:

1. A welcome letter, registration agreement and summary of fees will be sent upon acceptance.
2. The Student's enrolment is confirmed with the return of a **non-refundable deposit** and a signed **Registration Agreement**. These are both required to confirm the student's place at QMS.
3. The non-refundable deposit is credited toward your fees for the year.

## VISAS AND CONDITIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

**International STUDENTS** – Students who do not possess Canadian or US citizenship must arrive at the school with a Student Visa and a passport that is valid for the duration of the school year. For most students, this will be through June of the following year. *Please note visas can take up to 12 weeks to process. It is recommended that you apply early.*

**International PARENTS** – To qualify for Canadian fees, a parent must provide a copy of a valid Permanent Resident/Landed Immigrant document or a Work or Study Permit that is valid for the duration of the school year. A partial year permit will not qualify for domestic fees.

## EQUESTRIAN PROGRAM (optional for Grades 4-12)

- Opportunities to ride once to several times per week are available for novice to experienced riders.
- Students may ride a school horse, bring their horse or lease a horse at some program levels.
- Riding Deposits (Deposit confirms riding/boarding/leasing only. See Equestrian booklet for additional costs)

**Riding Program Non-Refundable Deposit: \$250. Horse Boarding or Leasing Non-Refundable Deposit: \$500**

*It is important to review the Equestrian Information Booklet and Equestrian Handbook for program options and costs.*

## ANNUAL FEES FOR BOARDING STUDENTS

Upon receipt of the Registration Agreement and payment of deposit, QMS will issue a LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE and notarized CUSTODIANSHIP DOCUMENT for **boarding students only**.

<sup>1</sup> Canadian Resident Fees: For parents born outside of Canada, a copy of the parent's Canadian Passport, Permanent Residence card, Landed Immigrant card, Study permit or Work visa must be provided to qualify for Canadian fees.

<sup>2</sup> An **English Language Learner (ELL) Program** is for students with emerging skills in English reading, writing, speaking, and listening. It is a required program if the need is determined during the assessment process.

## **PAYMENT OPTIONS – INTERNATIONAL**

Tuition payments may be made by Canadian e-transfer, cheque, Pay My Tuition ([www.paymytuition.com](http://www.paymytuition.com)), FLYWIRE ([www.qms.flywire.com](http://www.qms.flywire.com)), bank wire transfer, or credit card. Please note that credit card tuition payments will be charged a 3% convenience fee.

## **PAYMENT OPTIONS - CANADIAN BOARDERS**

Payments in full may be made by Canadian e-transfer, Canadian or US cash or money order, cheque, bank wire transfer, Pay My Tuition ([www.paymytuition.com](http://www.paymytuition.com)), FLYWIRE ([www.qms.flywire.com](http://www.qms.flywire.com)), or credit card. Payment made in full by credit card will not receive the \$600 pre-pay discount. Monthly payments made by credit card are subject to a 3% convenience fee.

Monthly Payments must be paid by pre-authorized debit or post-dated cheques. Payments are made in ten equal instalments at the beginning of each month from August 1, 2019 to May 1, 2020 inclusive. Monthly payments are subject to a \$35 per month administration fee.

## **TUITION ASSISTANCE FOR CANADIAN BOARDERS**

Canadian Families may receive a bursary to cover up to 40% of annual fees, based upon determined financial need.

A tuition assistance application will be provided upon request. All applications are held in confidence and application information will not be released to other areas of the School. We encourage families to apply early in the application process.
