Senator Mobina Jaffer was appointed to the Senate in 2001 and was the first Muslim senator, the first Africanborn senator, and the first senator of South Asian descent. From 2002 to 2005, she chaired the Canadian Committee on Women, Peace, and Security and currently chairs the Standing Senate Committee on Human Rights. Senator Jaffer's passion for protecting human rights, along with her advocacy for celebrating Canada's cultural diversity, made her the perfect guest speaker for QMS' Speech Day taking place on *Friday, June 13*th, **2014**.

"Senator Jaffer is a pioneer in the field of law and international dialogue," explains QMS Head of School Wilma Jamieson. "We are looking forward to welcoming her to QMS for our Grade 12 convocation, as I am certain our graduates and guests will find her message profound and inspirational."
