RIDING PROGRAM APPLICATION

The student is applying for **one** of following programs. **All programs include Equine Canada Rider Level Theory and Testing.**

Grade 4 – 12 LEARN TO RIDE – Mandatory for students with little or no prior riding experience; may be mandatory for riders with up to two years' riding experience. (No board or lease of horse is permitted). Lessons provide beginning riders with an introduction to riding skills, stable management, animal health and safe riding practices. Lessons take place outside of the school day.

Learn to Ride (LTR1) - one lesson per week, school horse provided - \$250 deposit required at time of registration

Grade 4 – 12 QMS Equestrians – For students with emerging to intermediate riding skills (Horse boarding or leasing is not required).

QMS Equestrians 1 (EQ1) - one lesson per week, school horse provided - \$250 deposit required at time of registration **OR/**

QMS Equestrians 2 (EQ2) - two lessons per week, school horse provided - \$250 deposit required at time of registration

Grade 4 – 12 Equine Masters – For students with emerging to advanced riding skills, Equine Canada Rider Levels 3-8 (Horse Boarding or leasing is required)

Equine Masters 3 (EM3) - three lessons/contacts per week, on own horse or leased horse, plus 6 horsemanship workshops- \$250 deposit required at time of registration **OR/**

Equine Masters 4 (EM4) - four lessons/contacts per week, on own horse or leased horse, plus 6 horsemanship workshops- \$250 deposit required at time of registration

Grade 8 – 12 Team QMS – For students with intermediate to advanced riding experience (Horse boarding or leasing is required).

Team QMS (TQ5) – five lessons/contacts per week on own horse or leased horse, plus 8 horsemanship workshops- \$250 deposit required at time of registration
