# **PROGRAM AGE REQUIRMENTS**

<u>Preschool:</u> applicants must be 3 years old by December 31 of their potential enrolment year. Junior Kindergarten: applicants must be 4 years old by December 31 of their potential enrolment year.

### SIBLING DISCOUNT FOR ECE STUDENTS

Students enrolled in our Early Childhood Education Program are not eligible for a sibling discount.

## **TUITION ASSISTANCE FOR CANADIAN ECE STUDENTS**

The Provincial Government offers the Affordable Childcare Benefit to BC families; a monthly payment to help with the cost of childcare. Factors like income, family size, and type of care determine how much support families may receive. Families need to renew their application every year. ## **APPLICATION AND ADMISSIONS DECISION**

- 1. Applications will be considered complete when the checklist items required have been uploaded and the application fee is paid.
- 2. All applicants will be invited for a Meet and Greet annually, at the end of March/beginning of April.
  - a. The Meet and Greet will be approximately 45 mins. to 1 hour in length, and allows applicants the opportunity to shadow, and meet other QMS ECE Students. During this time, parent(s) will meet our ECE Staff, and Assistant Director of Admissions.
- 3. Following the Meet and Greet, the Admissions Committee will meet to review applicants. Our admissions Department will notify all applicants of their final decision. Applicants will receive one of the following admissions decisions:
  - a. **Offer:** Acceptance is based on whether an applicant is mission appropriate and is subject to available space.
  - b. **Wait-Pool:** this offer is extended to students who have been found mission appropriate, but the program is full for the academic year. Students will be held in our wait-pool until available space can be identified. At such a time, families will be contacted through the Admissions Department.
  - c. **Declined:** Sometimes children are just not ready yet. Those that are declined are invited to apply for the following admissions year.

### **ENROLMENT**

All offers will be sent by email and will include a: Letter of Offer, Tuition Fee Invoice and Registration Contract. The applicant's enrolment will be confirmed with the return of a non-refundable \$1,000 deposit and a signed Registration Contract; both of which will be due two weeks after the acceptance has been sent.

### **ANNUAL RE-ENROLMENT:**

<u>Preschool:</u> families are given first opportunity to move forward into Junior Kindergarten, before external candidates are considered. Our Admissions Department will reach out to families to determine your interest in moving forward. Once your programing has been reviewed by the ECE Program Manager, our Admissions team will follow up by email to confirm, and with instructions on next steps.

Junior Kindergarten: families are given first opportunity to enrol into kindergarten before external candidates are considered. Our Admissions Department will reach out to families to determine your interest in moving forward. Once your intentions have been received, we will communicate the date that your child(ren) will be attending their Kindergarten Readiness Assessment. The Brigance screening test is widely used by schools for students going into kindergarten and covers a variety of school-based curriculum topics, including language development and gross motor skills. This process considers each child's social, emotional, and cognitive development in order to ensure your child is set up for success in our enriched Kindergarten program. our Admissions team will follow up by email to confirm, and with instructions on next steps.

To confirm re-enrolment in either program, a \$1,000 non-refundable deposit, and a signed Registration Contract are due within two (2) weeks of the re-enrolment confirmation email sent.
