TUITION ASSISTANCE FOR CANADIAN ECE STUDENTS:

The Provincial Government offers the Affordable Child Care Benefit to BC families; a monthly payment to help with the cost of childcare. Factors like income, family size, and type of care determine how much support families may receive. Families need to renew their application every year. Please visit the Affordable Child Care Benefit website for more information and how to apply.

SIBLING DISCOUNT FOR ECE STUDENTS:

- Students enrolled in our Early Childhood Education Program are not eligible for a sibling discount.
- Families with more than one child enrolled in kindergarten to grade 12, are eligible to receive a 20% sibling discount on each of the younger children's tuition fees.

REGISTRATION

If accepted, we will send the applicant an Acceptance Letter and Registration Contract. The applicant's enrolment will be confirmed with the return of a **non-refundable \$500 deposit** and a **signed Registration Contract**; both of which will be due two weeks after the acceptance has been sent.

ANNUAL RE-ENROLMENT

<u>PRESCHOOL</u>: Every year families will receive a Junior Kindergarten Programming Request Form. This will give current preschool families the opportunity to move forward into Junior Kindergarten before any external candidates are accepted. The applicant's enrolment is confirmed with the return of a **non-refundable deposit** and a **signed Annual Registration Contract**; <u>both of which will be due two weeks after the acceptance has been sent</u>.

JUNIOR KINDERGARTEN: Every year families will receive a Kindergarten Information letter. This will give current Junior Kindergarten families the opportunity to apply to kindergarten before any external candidates are accepted. Each applicant will go through the Brigance Screening. The Brigance screening test is widely used by schools for students going into kindergarten and covers a variety of school-based curriculum topics, including language development and gross motor skills. This process considers each child's social, emotional, and cognitive development in order to ensure your child is set up for success in our enriched Kindergarten program. If accepted, the Admissions Department will send the applicant an Acceptance Letter and Registration Contract. The applicant's enrolment will be confirmed with the return of a non-refundable deposit, and a signed Registration Contract; which will be due two weeks after the acceptance has been sent.
