An easy walk for people of all abilities to experience one of the world's largest freestanding timber rail trestle structures.



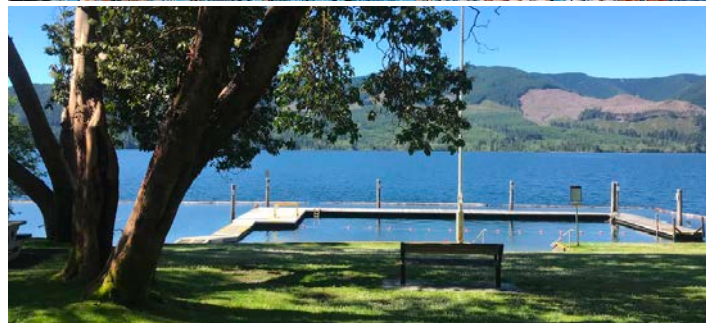
Chemainus Murals
